The National Research Foundation (NRF) of Singapore is organizing an international multi-disciplinary research summit, titled the Global Young Scientists Summit@one-north (GYSS@one-north) in Singapore from 20 to 25 January, 2013. The theme of the inaugural GYSS@one-north is Advancing Science, Creating Technologies for a Better World. It aims to address key areas of science & research, technology innovation & society, and solutions to global challenges.

Coupling the basic sciences of chemistry, physics and medicine, with mathematics, computer science and engineering, the GYSS@one-north aims to inspire and excite bright young scientists, through close interactions with eminent scientific and technology leaders, to apply themselves to research which addresses major global challenges and the future needs of mankind.

The Summit provides a unique platform for young researchers to connect and engage with like-minded peers from around the world to build a strong global research network. Additionally, the Singapore Challenge, an integral part of the GYSS@one-north programme, will invite participants to propose innovative solutions to an identified challenge.
