TERMS OF REFERENCE

Consultancy for Training of key preschool teachers on developing and organising learning through play activities for children

I. BACKGROUND

Plan is an international humanitarian, child-centred community development organization without religious, political or government affiliation. Plan Vietnam, in cooperation with the local authorities, is currently implementing projects in 15 provinces and cities in the northern and central regions of the country. Plan Vietnam has a new Country Strategic Plan (CSP3) for 2011-2016, which outlines the situation of children, and Plan's response to these issues in the areas of health, education, livelihoods, child protection, water and environmental sanitation.

Based on the design of The Education program under the new CSP3, Plan designed the project of Early Childhood Care and Development which will carry out in Gia Lai province from 2011-2017. The project's overall goal is to reach Education for All targets in Gia Lai Province by improving young children's development and wellbeing through effective and holistic early childhood interventions. Four mid-term outcomes are described:

- 1) Improved young children's development status, with a focus on 0-3, through enhanced support from community-based care and early stimulation initiatives in targeted communities.
- 2) All children aged 3-5 participate in quality and culturally appropriate formal or non-formal early learning opportunities, including a dedicated school readiness program for 5 year olds.
- 3) Improved quality of pre-school to primary school transition of children aged 6-8 in ethnic minority areas.
- 4) An improved and more integrated policy environment related to ECD.

The project will promote more effective and better quality ECCD in 7 communes of 04 disadvantaged and mountainous districts of Gia Lai province as below.

Learn through Play is practical for young child development. To build up capacity for preschool teachers' skills on how to develop and organize learning activities through playing (exploring activities the local cultural practices), Plan in Vietnam is seeking a consultant/team to conduct 2 TOT trainings for key preschool teachers on learning through play activities for children.
