



Vacancy announcement

As a federal enterprise, the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH supports the German Government in achieving its objectives in the field of international cooperation for sustainable development. We work in a variety of fields and support our cooperation partners in designing strategies and meeting their policy goals. GIZ Viet Nam is currently engaged in three priority areas: 1) Vocational training; 2) Environmental policy and sustainable natural resource use; 3) Energy.

The **GIZ Energy Support Programme** is working with the General Directorate of Energy (GDE) / Ministry of Industry and Trade (MOIT) on the development of the energy sector in Vietnam. The programme consists of two main projects: **“Support to the Up-scaling of Wind Power”** and **“Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency”** (both commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ)). The current technological focus is on wind power, bioenergy, and energy efficiency.

Through this vacancy announcement, the project is looking for a local qualified candidate to complement the team of the project **“Support to the Up-scaling of Wind Power”**. The project consists of three components: (1) Policy and Regulatory Frameworks; (2) Capacity Development; (3) Technology Cooperation. The project is looking for a

Project Officer “Technology Cooperation Wind Power”

Duty station: Hanoi, Vietnam

Duration: 2 years (with the possibility of extension)

The Project Officer will support the overall successful implementation of the up-scaling of wind energy project in the Action Area 3 - Technology Cooperation.

Main tasks:

- Develop concepts, organize, and implement Vietnamese-German dialogue fora and match-making events/conferences to promote technology transfer for sustainable market development and knowledge exchange on wind power;
- Develop and implement networks and structures to foster cooperation between Vietnamese and German academic institutions, e.g. through research projects and summer schools;
- Develop and implement networks and structures to foster cooperation between Vietnamese and German businesses;
- Develop or supervise market research or specific studies, e.g. for manufacturing capacities of wind power components in Vietnam;
- Develop concepts and organize industry events, large conferences, exhibitions, training activities for selected target groups on national and international level;
- Liaise closely with businesses and academic/ research institutions, including universities, research associations, chambers of commerce, companies;
- Develop activities that support companies in engaging in the wind power market in Vietnam
- Develop formats and tools for effective communication and sharing of market information for the wind power sector, e.g. through web communication, newsletters, etc.;
- Monitor and supervise local and international consultants for projects under this component
- Monitor activities, e.g. through surveys for ex-post evaluations of events and workshops;
- Prepare reports and presentation materials

Minimum requirements:

- Masters degree in economics, business, environmental sciences, or related field;
- At least 5 years of professional working experience, work experience abroad will be an asset;
- Working experience in supporting research or academic teaching
- Working experience with setting-up networking platforms, events and business databases;
- Experience in the (renewable) energy sector is an asset;
- Impeccable oral and written English and Vietnamese skills; German language skills are an asset;
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills;
- Team player with a self-motivated character;
- Ability to develop concepts and ideas in an independent, result-oriented manner;
- Proven project management skills; Excellent command of MS-Office
- Willingness to travel on short trips, both within Vietnam and, possibly, to Germany
