Reporting to the Country Director, the Senior Manager, Program Support and Innovation is responsible for the strategic development of programmatic support areas throughout Vietnam, including Construction Quality, Water & Sanitation, Disaster Response and Mitigation, Housing Finance and

Design/Planning/Monitoring/Evaluation. The Senior Manager, Program Support and Innovation will provide management, coordination, and guidance in the development, implementation and evaluation of program technical and functional initiatives and support for Habitat for Humanity Vietnam program operations across the country in close coordination with the Program Director to ensure that HFHV is delivering relevant, high-quality, affordable and cost-effective housing products and services for families in need of decent housing.
